

## NOTICE TO UNDERGRADUATE PHYSICS MAJORS

### *Richard D. Schwartz Undergraduate Scholarship for Physics Majors For the 2008-2009 Academic Year*

Applications are being accepted for the Richard D. Schwartz Undergraduate Scholarship for Physics Majors. The amount of the award is \$1500 per year and may be renewable for up to two years. The Scholarship will be awarded for the 2008-2009 academic year in May at the Alumni Awards Luncheon. To be eligible for the Scholarship you must satisfy all of the following:

1. You must be in the high need category for financial aid. The combined federal adjusted gross income of the student (and the student's family if under the age of 24) reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be less than or equal to \$40,000 per year and the student must have financial need as defined by federal financial aid regulations. Students may apply free online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
2. You must be a full-time student at UM-St. Louis majoring in physics with junior or senior standing. This means you have successfully completed Physics 2112 (or equivalent) by the end of WS2007.
3. You must be in good academic standing with the University. You may not apply if you are on academic probation.

In the event there are several applicants satisfying all of the criteria above, we will select the applicant with the highest GPA in physics.
