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The central aim of the Honors College admissions process is informational. We want to know as much as we can about your abilities and ambitions, and we want you to know as much as you can about the Honors College and its academic program. Accordingly, we ask you as an applicant to send to us two of your best essays written for high school or college courses and have two letters of recommendation sent directly from high school or college instructors.

We invite most applicants to the Honors College for a guided tour and an admissions interview, during which you will have the opportunity to ask us questions.

The letters of recommendation should be written on official school/college stationery or E-mailed from a school or campus E-mail address and should contain instructors' evaluation of your academic accomplishments thus far and of your potential as a University student. Your references are welcome to comment on other matters, too (for instance, on your abilities to contribute to the social and cultural activities of the Honors College).

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Please submit two essays with your application to PLHC. Both essays will be reviewed, and one will be graded by our Director of Writing. At least one of the essays must be a formal essay, not a personal narrative or fictional writing. Research papers may be submitted as the formal essay. The second essay may be a formal composition, personal narrative, or fictional piece. They do not need to be 'clean' copies; indeed, we like to see the comments your teachers have made on your work. Please ensure that your name and address are on each essay's title page.

**Honors College tour and interview:** For most applicants, the information process will continue with an invitation to visit the Honors College for a guided tour of the College, during which you will have a chance to talk to our students and have an individual admissions interview, usually with the Dean or Associate Dean. During or at the end of the admissions interview, we will tell you our admissions decision; and if we offer you admission to the Honors College, we will also tell you if you will be considered for Honors College merit scholarships. Both the admissions and scholarship offers will be confirmed by a letter sent to your home address. Applicants unable to travel to the College may be interviewed by telephone.

Our admissions interviews and tours normally take place on Fridays during daytime office hours (8 a.m.-5 p.m.). Family members are welcome to take part in the tour and, if the applicant wishes, to sit in on the interview. Admissions interviews at Pierre LaCledé Honors College are informal and informational, not inquisitorial, and are aimed principally at informing applicants about the Honors College and its academic program. If we do offer you admission, we want to ensure that you know enough about us to make the right choice.
