

UMSL e-Consent

All students signing in to MyView for the first time will be prompted to e-Consent. When students agree to e-Consent, they are granting the University permission to communicate student records, financial aid and billing information with them electronically. MyView is an electronic form of communication so students must first agree to the UMSL e-Consent policy before they can access their student records, financial aid and billing information in their MyView Student Center.

Students who have not agreed to the e-Consent policy have a 'No Consent' service indicator on their student account. This is an informative service indicator and has no impact on student registration or other services outside of MyView. The 'No Consent' service indicator is removed from the students account once the student agrees to the e-Consent policy.

Agree to e-Consent

Once a student has signed in to Myview (myview.umsl.edu) with their MyGateway ID and password, the welcome page shown below will be displayed.

The student should click one of the UM e-Consent links, read the policy (below) and click the agree button at the bottom of the page.

UMSL e-Consent for MyView Access

e-Consent for Campus Finance/Student Records access allows you to access your student account and financial aid information online and gives permission for Cashiers, Student Financial Aid, and the Registrar's office to exchange emails with you regarding person specific information. You have the right to receive your financial notices in printed format. However, with your e-Consent, your transactions can be processed faster than if you have to wait for mail from our offices or conduct business in person. The choice is yours.

You must read and agree to the following information and conditions in order to complete the Campus Finance/Student Records e-Consent process. You may withdraw your e-Consent at any time by completing an e-Consent Withdrawal Form, available from the UMSL Registrar's Office, 351 Millennium Student Center.

By granting e-Consent, you will have full access to the following electronic information and online processes:

- MyView Student Center including Cashiers, Financial Aid and Records & Registration.
- Student account and billing information, including aid disbursements and refunds.
- Financial Aid application status online, including a list of incomplete financial aid steps.
- Financial Aid package, including ability to accept, decline or reduce offers online.
- Promissory note completion and loan processing requirements.
- Registration, adding, and dropping classes, viewing semester grades and the ability to change mailing addresses online.
- Receiving the following notices to your UMSL e-mail account:
 - Billing status and due date
 - Reminder notices when there are upcoming deadlines regarding your finances.
 - Reminder notices if something in your Financial Aid file is incomplete.
 - Disbursements and refund availability.
 - Messages from the Registrar's office regarding priority registration and enrollment dates along with other information related to the beginning and end of semester academic policies and procedures.
 - Be allowed to make requests with our offices through e-mail for student specific information or adjustments.

If you do not consent, you should know no access will be available to the following electronic information and online processes:

- Financial Aid information and processes.
- Billing information.
- Student records information and processes (end of term grade reports will not be mailed regardless of your e-Consent decision).
- No electronic correspondence will be permitted with Cashiers, Student Financial Aid, and Registrar's offices:
 - All correspondence will be sent through the U. S. Postal Service, which may delay processing.
 - No e-mail exchanges will be allowed between you and staff in Cashiers, Student Financial Aid and the Registrar's Office.
 - Even if you designate someone as authorized to access your information through a FERPA release, no e-mail exchanges will be allowed between them and staff in Cashiers or Student Financial Aid.
 - All requests must be made in writing or in person.
 - If your mailing address is not kept current with the University, you may experience significant delays.

(By clicking this button you acknowledge that you have read and understand the information above, and that you consent to do business electronically with UMSL's Cashiers, Student Financial Aid, and Registrar's Offices. You will then be allowed access to Campus Finance/Student Records within MyView Self Service.)

(By clicking this button you acknowledge that you have read and understand the information above, and that you choose to handle all business with UMSL's Cashiers, Student Financial Aid, and Registrar's offices on paper or in person (end of semester grade reports will not be mailed to students regardless of your e-Consent decision). You should also click this button if you are unsure whether or not you want to grant consent. You will not be allowed access to Campus Finance/Student Records within MyView Self Service.)

After the student clicks the agree button, they will be signed out of MyView. The student should then sign back into MyView with their MyGateway ID and password. Once a student has signed back into Myview, a new welcome page (shown below) will be displayed. This is the welcome page that the student will see from now on.

Financial Aid: LIVE March 3rd! Current students applying for aid for the Fall 2008 semester can review the status of the financial aid application in MyView. View your To Do list in the Student Center to check the status of your financial aid application.

Cashiers: Through the MyView student system, students can access real-time detailed account and billing information maintain direct deposit and eBill user profiles and make a payment through one convenient location in the Self Service Student Center.

The students account summary and links to view and manage account information are displayed upon entering the Student Center, along with drill-down links to holds and to do lists.

From the Account Inquiry page, students can search their account activity for specific transactions or filter their activity for a specific date or a range of dates. Students can also view and filter all posted and pending payment activity.

To use the 'View Bill', 'Maintain Authorized Users' or 'Make a Payment' links in the MyView student center you must set your internet browser to accept pop-ups from MyView.

Student Records: The Enrollment section contains the links you will use in April to register for Summer and Fall 2008. Currently enrolled students can begin registering, by appointment, for Summer/Fall 2008 classes in MyView on April 7th. Registration appointments will be emailed to students in mid-March. The links in the Academic History section are available, however we are in the midst of converting academic data from our former student information system and the data may not be complete at this time. Thank you for your patience during our implementation of the MyView system.

Winter/Spring 2008 Academic records must be processed in CICS. Once the term has been finalized and degrees posted those completed records will be brought over to MyView.

Currently enrolled students will begin registering, by appointment, for Summer/Fall 2008 classes in MyView on April 7th. Newly admitted and returning students may register for Summer/Fall 2008 beginning April 21st.
