

Report from the Faculty Senate Committee on Appointments, Tenure and Promotion

January 23, 2007

The Senate Committee on Appointments, Tenure and Promotion met on January 3, 2007 to consider 17 cases as follows:

- 9 cases for tenure and promotion from the rank of Assistant Professor to Associate Professor with tenure;
- 3 cases for tenure from the rank of Associate Professor (without tenure) to Associate Professor with tenure; and
- 5 cases for promotion from the rank of Associate Professor to Professor.

In accordance with the University of Missouri – St. Louis Procedures Concerning Tenure and Promotion (approved by Faculty Senate 2/15/05), the ATP Committee's recommendation for each candidate was forwarded to Chancellor George. A copy of each ATP Committee recommendation was forwarded to Provost Cope, the candidate, and each candidate's Dean, Unit Chair, and Unit Committee Coordinator.
