Rationale

1) Removed the requirement for Jazz Keyboard Harmony II -- this class has been added to the Core Curriculum (by way of an exception/footnote) 2) Added the requirement for Jazz Arranging (THRY COM 3411) -- this class was previously listed under the Core Curriculum (by way of an exception/footnote), but has been eliminated from that part of the Bulletin. Since we wish to keep the course as part of this degree, we are adding it back in here. 3) Reformatted degree appearance (added headings for "Ensemble" and "Jazz Combo/Improvisation" for the relevant classes). 4) Within this reformatting, we have aimed to clarify (in language parallel to all of our other degree programs) that EN PER 1550 Jazz Orchestra is the major ensemble for students in this major, and they must take that class every semester, for a minimum of 4 credit hours. Two semesters of Wind Ensemble (EN PER 1530) are also required, which is reduced from 8 credits as previously required by the Music Core Curriculum. (The Music Core is also simultaneously under review for approval, with language that makes it clear that Jazz Orchestra, not Wind Ensemble, is the primary major ensemble for Jazz Studies majors.) 5) Also within this reformatting, we have increased the number of semesters/credits required of Jazz Combo (EN PER 1542) and Improvisation classes (PRACTM 1200 and 2200) to 8 semesters. These are foundational classes, commonly required to be taken for the student's entire career by other peer institutions. These added credits are balanced out by the removal of 6 credits of Wind Ensemble as described in Rationale #4 above -- the net credit change is 0.
