This was my error (Meuser) which I wish to correct now. 5361 and 5376 are the graduate level versions of 4361 and 4376. Their omission from the Bulletin was causing confusion for students.</p> <p>6497 was not in the 2007 Bulletin as meeting this requirement, but it was listed in materials I inherited as the new Program Director in 2007. I added it to make our advising process consistent. This has not worked out as planned, however, and should go back to how it was originally (i.e. as an elective only).</p> <p>Geron 6458 is no longer offered through Optometry and is not part of their Bulletin listing. It should be deleted.</p> <p>The content of Soc Wk 6120 is appropriate to fill this requirement, and listing it is helpful now that Gerontology is part of Social Work and actively training MSW students. It should be added.</p>
