Advanced Credit Program University-Bound Scholarship Application

Scholarship Application Checklist

Step 1

Complete the UM–St. Louis Admissions application process, including high school transcript and ACT scores. (Note: You will need a second official copy of your high school transcript to submit with your scholarship application. See Step 2.)

- You must apply for admission and be accepted to UM–St. Louis to be considered for this scholarship. You can apply online at www.umsl.edu/admission/apply, or on a PDF form available at www.umsl.edu/admission/pdfs/application.pdf.
- Submit to the UM–St. Louis Office of Admissions. Direct any questions concerning admission to Drew Griffin at (314) 516-6941 or via e-mail at griffina@umsl.edu.
- Only students who have been accepted for admission to UM–St. Louis are eligible for this scholarship.

Step 2

Complete an ACP UMSL University-Bound Scholarship application packet, consisting of the following:

- Completed scholarship application form
- High school transcript, reflecting class rank and ACT score
- Essay of no more than 500 words in response to the question:
Why did you choose to enroll in the Advanced Credit Program, and how has your participation helped you prepare for the beginning of your college career?

Step 3

Download the Request for Letter of Recommendation form and instructions, and solicit letters of recommendation from two adults:

- One letter MUST** be from a teacher, counselor, or principal who can discuss your academic abilities.
- The other can be from any adult who knows you well, such as a coach, employer, scout leader, or religious mentor.

Each Request for Letter of Recommendation form and accompanying letter must be sent by the writer directly to Dr. Kathleen Burns. Remember to provide the writers with a stamped envelope addressed to Dr. Burns at the address in Step 4.
