For UM-St. Louis language students

Modern Language Alumni Scholarship

- Applicants must be a declared language major.
- Must have junior or senior standing in the Department (i.e., be enrolled in 3200 or 4300 level foreign language courses).
- Must have completed at least six hours of language courses at UMSL.
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 in the department and an overall cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- To apply, submit a letter of application describing your professional plans to use the language and how the scholarship will be of benefit to you. List at least one faculty member in your language major as a reference, and enclose a copy of your transcript.
- This \$700 scholarship is to be applied for educational fees toward enrollment in upper-level courses in French, German, or Spanish and must be used within one semester of the award.

Modern Language German Scholarship

For community college students transferring to UM-St. Louis

Community College Language Scholarship

- Applicants must have completed a minimum of 3 courses in the same foreign language, namely French, German, or Spanish, at a community college. Applicants must be a declared language major.
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 in the language and an overall cumulative GPA of 3.0 at the community college level.
- To apply, submit a letter of application describing your professional plans to use the language and how the scholarship will be of benefit to you, and enclose a copy of your transcript of courses taken at the community college level.
- This \$700 scholarship is to be applied for educational fees toward enrollment in the third semester or higher level courses in the particular language and must be used within one semester of the award.

Community College German Scholarship

The Scholarship may be applied to educational fees for German courses or to study abroad in a German-speaking Country. For details on eligibility criteria and application procedure, contact Mr. Kersten Horn at 314-516-6243 or hornke@umsl.edu.
