

Students earning degrees through the College of Business Administration are required to complete:
 60 credit hours of non-business coursework
 30 hours of core business coursework
 18 hours of Business Electives at the Junior/Senior Level (which includes the Accounting coursework)
 12 hours of business or non-business approved electives credit hours (which includes Com 1030, 1040 or BUS AD 3100)
 120 credits

Students must complete a minimum of 60 hours of non-business coursework that includes:

I. BASIC SKILLS:

- A. English Composition: English 1100 A minimum grade of C- is
- B. Junior Level English: English 3120 required for each course.

II. UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION AND COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The general education requirements and the specific pre-professional requirements of the College of Business Administration are as follows:

- A. Three (3) courses in Humanities - must include Phil. 1130 or Phil. 2254
- B. Five (5) courses in Social Science to include: Econ 1001-Micro, Econ 1002-Macro, one course to meet the state requirement, and two additional courses in Social Sciences.
- C. Four (4) courses in Mathematics/Science: Math 1030, Math 1100, Math 1105, and one lecture course in either a natural or physical science.
- D. Three (3) courses in Global Awareness to include one cultural diversity studies course.
- E. A minimum of 42 hours Breadth of Study. (To be selected from Humanities, Social Sciences and Math/Science)
- F. Communication 1030, 1040, or 3305
- G. A minimum of 60 hours of approved non-business administration coursework.

A minimum grade of a C- is required for all core courses except MGMT 4219.

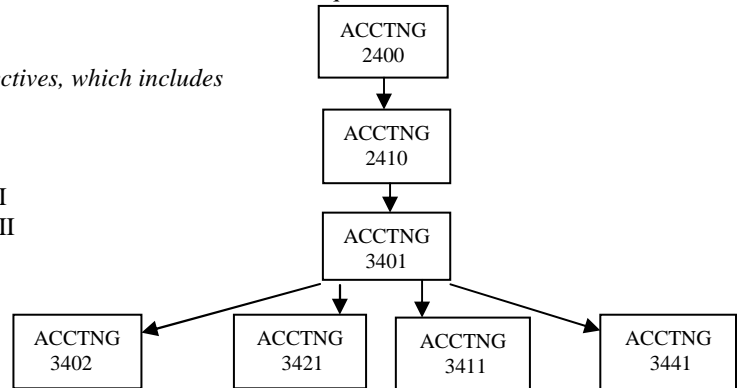
* The prerequisite course, INFSYS 1800, can be waived by exam.

**Special Consent form needed for MGMT 4219: Strategic Management. One assessment test is required: MGMT 4220: Business Assessment Test.

IV. ACCOUNTING REQUIREMENTS:

A student must complete a minimum 18 credit hours in business electives, which includes the following 5 courses (15 hrs.):

- ACCTNG 3401 Financial Accounting & Reporting I
- ACCTNG 3402 Financial Accounting & Reporting II
- ACCTNG 3411 Cost Accounting
- ACCTNG 3421 Accounting Information Systems
- ACCTNG 3441 Income Taxes



Business hours: Minimum 48; Maximum 60 within 120

V. To be eligible for the Missouri CPA exam, 150 credit hours are required. Accounting majors need an additional 12 hours in Accounting (including ACCTNG 4435 Auditing).
