II. UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION AND COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS (PRIOR TO FALL 2002):

The general education requirements and the specific pre-professional requirements of the College of Business Administration are as follows:

- A. Three (3) courses in Humanities
- B. Five (5) courses in Social Science to include: Econ 1001, Econ 1002, one course to meet state requirement and two additional courses in Social Sciences
- C. Four (4) courses in Mathematics/Science: Math 1030, Math 1100, Math 1105 and one lecture course in either a natural or physical science
- D. Three (3) courses in Global Awareness to include one Cultural Diversity Studies course
- E. A minimum of 42 hours Breadth of Study (To be selected from Humanities, Social Science and Math/Science)
- F. A minimum of 60 hours of approved non-business administration coursework
