Degree Program

Upon admission, students select a Functional Role as their specialization which determines their degree program plan.

Nurse Educator: A minimum of 41 credit hours and 256 clinical hours

Nurse Practitioner: A minimum of 43 credit hours and 600 clinical hours.

Application Requirements

1. Application

2. Official transcripts from all universities attended are required. Applicants must have completed a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) and nursing licensure before beginning the master's program. Transcripts must document a course in differential/inferential statistics.

3. Grade Point Average

Minimum of 3.0 on 4.0 scale.

4. Entrance examinations

International students are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.

5. Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation.

b. Nurse Practitioner only: Document completion of an undergraduate health assessment course and minimum two years clinical experience within the last five years with selected population.
