- M.Ed. Secondary Education – adding TESOL as an emphasis area (HOLD for PC form)
- Ph.D. Metropolitan and Regional History (new) HOLD. The proposal was discussed and questions were formulated for the chair of the department. His response will be forwarded to Council for a decision before the next Senate meeting.
