Minimum 90 hrs postbaccalaureate consisting of a) Foundations (12 hrs); b) Research Methods (6 hrs Quantitative research methodology and 6 hrs Qualitative research methodology); c) Common doctoral seminars (6 hrs); d) Major Specialization (21-39 hrs in one of the following Educational Administration, Adult and Higher Education, Teaching-Learning Processes, Counselor Education); e) Minor Specialization (12-18 hrs in a secondary area of expertise identified in consultation with the advisory committee); f) Dissertation (12 hrs).
