Degree program information

1. Coursework. Minimum 60 hours consisting of psychological and educational foundations, assessment, and direct interventions. The program emphasizes prevention and early intervention of academic, behavioral, and social-emotional problems through consultation, interdisciplinary collaboration, and systems-level interventions.
2. Internships
 - a. 500-hours of supervised practicum
 - b. Fulltime (1,400-hours) internship in schools for one academic year.

3. Graduate Record Examination (General and Writing) (<http://www.gre.org/ttindex.html>).
 - b. International students are also required to document English proficiency (<http://www.umsl.edu/divisions/graduate/prospective/international.html>).
4. Grade Point Average: Minimum of 3.0 on 4.0 scale
5. Personal statement describing professional goals (not to exceed five double-spaced typed pages)
6. Personal interview with members of the school psychology faculty.
7. Prerequisite coursework in developmental psychology and statistics is required for admission.

Applications are reviewed annually with a *February 15* deadline.
