Degree program information:

Coursework

A minimum of 18 credit hours numbered 4000 or above taken as part of a doctoral program. Of the 18 credit hours, 12 hours are in the required core (6 credit hours in research methods/6 credit hours in Institutional Research seminar), 3 credit hours are in Higher Education (HIR ED) or an Educational Research (ED REM) elective and 3 credit hours are in a capstone. Students may transfer up to 5 hours of post-Master's work into the program with the approval of the advisor.
