1. Coursework

An 18-credit hour program, of which a minimum of 12 hours are at the 5000 level or above. The Certificate, sponsored by the Gateway Writing Project (GWP), includes a 12 semester-hour core of courses (6 hours in invitational institute, a designated 3 hour "topics" course and a 3 hour exit course). The remaining 6 hours of electives, may be chosen from approved courses in English or Education.
