3. Entrance examinations
 - a) There are no entrance exams for domestic students.

4. Grade Point Average
Minimum of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Students whose total undergraduate GPA and major GPA are between 2.75 and 2.99 may be admitted on a restricted basis.
