Master of Science (MS) in Computer Science

Degree Program

Requires 30 hours of course work. Students must satisfy all core requirements.

Non-thesis option: Students complete the 30 hours in courses.

Thesis Option: Students writing a thesis enroll in 6 hours of CS 6900, Thesis, and defend their thesis in an oral exam administered by a committee of three department members, including the thesis director.

Application Requirements

1. Application

2. Two letters of recommendation

Letters of recommendations from persons qualified to evaluate the student's recent work are required. A third letter is required to apply for an assistantship.

3. Official transcripts from all universities attended

Applicants must have completed a baccalaureate in Computer Science or a related discipline before beginning the master's program. Transcripts must show the following coursework, or students must complete the work prior to starting their MS degree: C programming, object oriented programming language (C++ or Java), data structures, assembly language programming, computer architecture, or computer organization, an elementary course in algorithms and analysis, advanced programming with UNIX, two semesters of calculus, linear algebra, discrete mathematics, and an elementary course in probability or statistics.

4. Entrance examinations

a. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) General Test is required only to apply for an assistantship (see <http://www.gre.org/ttindex.html>). The GRE Subject Test in Computer Science is strongly recommended for applicants without a degree in Computer Science.

b. International students are required to document English proficiency (<http://www.umsl.edu/divisions/graduate/prospective/international.html>).

5. Grade Point Average

Minimum of 3.25 on 4.0 scale. Students whose overall GPA is 2.75 to 3.24 may be admitted under some circumstances.
