Two curricular items were presented to the Graduate Council for immediate action.

**Counseling Education 6050 “Individual Inventory”.** The Department of counseling requests a change in the prerequisite.

**Current:** “Ed Rem 6709

**Proposed:** “An introductory statistics course or consent of instructor”.

**Rationale:** After a recent review of the new CACREP standards (Accreditation body for the counseling program), it was determined that an introductory statistics course is all that is necessary to meet the prerequisites for the CE 6050 Individual inventory course.

**Graduate Certificate in Forensic Economics.** The Economics faculty wishes to inactivate the Forensic Economics certificate. Information on the certificate was pulled from the Bulletin but never formally inactivated.
