

Interlibrary Loan for Distance Students (ILL)

UM – St. Louis Distance Nursing Students may request (using Interlibrary Loan) journal articles that are **not** available full text in one of the UM-St. Louis Library databases.

1. You may request up to **10** *articles* or *book chapters* per week from Interlibrary Loan.
2. To order items from ILL, you must be a currently enrolled student (or distance student) at UMSL and have no outstanding library fines.
3. ILL requests take 1-2 weeks to fill. Because you are distance students, your requested material will be sent directly to your home via email or snail mail.
4. It is very important that you indicate that you are a **DISTANCE STUDENT**. You must also provide an **email address** or provide complete **home address** information so that your request can be mailed to you.

5. When you are searching in a database (*CINAHL*) you must check for full text *before* you can request and item through ILL. Click on **Article Linker** or a **Full Text** link.

8. If you are **not in a database** and wish to request articles through ILL follow these steps to make an Interlibrary Loan request:
 - a. Go to <http://www.umsl.edu/library>
 - b. Click on the Interlibrary Loan link located under **Library Services**.
 - c. Find the link [Click here to Request Materials Via ILL](#).
 - d. After you have clicked on the link to submit an ILL request, you will be linked to the login page for the WebZap ILL system.
 - e. (1) You will need to enter your Student ID Number (on your Student ID Card) to login; (2) When you enter your **FIRST NAME** put the words "**Distance Student**" after your first name. (*i.e.*: *Jean Distance Student*)
 - f. The first time you login, you will need to enter your name and address information. Every subsequent time, this information will be saved and you will just need to fill out the information about the item you are requesting.
 - g. When requesting a journal article the "**Where Citation Found**" field must be filled in with the name of the database: *CINAHL, Health Source: Nursing Academic, etc.*
 - h. Choose **Email-Electronic Delivery** for the quickest delivery of articles. An article received by email can be viewed up to **5 times** in a **7 day** period.
