Admission Criteria

- Admission to the University of Missouri–St. Louis
- Graduation from a State Board approved associate degree or diploma nursing program
- Evidence of current licensure as a registered nurse with eligibility for licensure in Missouri
- Completion of at least 30 academic (non-nursing) credit hours, with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale)

The BSN Completion Option at UMSL's College of Nursing is fully accredited by the Commission for Collegiate Nursing Education—the nationally recognized accrediting body for baccalaureate and higher degree programs—and fully approved by the Missouri State Board of Nursing.

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree requires 120 credit hours. BSN Completion students are required to complete 31 credit hours of nursing courses, including nursing statistics, and 51 credit hours of general education requirements. BSN Completion students may transfer general education credit hours from community colleges and other accredited colleges and universities (with the exception of Junior Level Writing, which must be taken at UMSL). Students are awarded 39 credit hours for their associate or diploma nursing courses. The University of Missouri-St. Louis requires that 24 of the last 30 credit hours be taken at UMSL.

The University of Missouri – St. Louis offers its BSN Completion Option at the following sites: UMSL, St. Louis Community College @ Forest Park, St. Charles Community College, UMSL West County Continuing Education Center. Additionally, we offer a BSN Completion Program that can be done completely *online*. Please note that the cost of the program will vary, according to which location you choose (i.e. UMSL, off-campus or online).
