Context
In 2007 and 2002 UMSL seniors worked more than 20 hours per week off campus.
UMSL freshmen worked 11-15 hours per week off campus in 2007 but more than 15 hrs per wk in 2002.
In 2007 Urban seniors worked over 10 hours per week; Doc-Int and NSSE worked over 5 hours per wk.. In 2002 Urban seniors had worked almost 16-20 hrs per wk.
In 2002 and 2007, Urban freshmen worked over 10 hrs per wk; Doc-Int and NSSE worked over 5 hrs per wk.
Changes:
In 2007 Doc-Int freshmen and seniors worked off campus fewer hours than they did in 2002 while UMSL students remained the same. Doc-Int seniors worked more hours off campus in 2002 than they did in 2007.
