Our summer programs welcome undergraduates, graduate students, and life-long learners.

Creative Writing

Sponsored by the University of Missouri-St. Louis, the University of Arkansas and the National University of Ireland-Galway students take a workshop in fiction or poetry, and a course in Irish Literature. Courses are led by Irish poet Moya Cannon and American novelist and short story writer Mary Troy.

\$3850 includes instruction, housing, health insurance, a weekend trip to Inishbofin, guest writers, and other cultural activities. Credit will be awarded through the University of Arkansas: \$1177 for 6 undergraduate credits and \$2010 for 6 graduate credits.

Irish Studies Program

In its eleventh year, this program allows students to earn 6 hours of transfer credit from NUI-Galway by choosing two courses in Irish Studies and studying with NUI-Galway faculty.

Excursions include day trips to the Aran Islands, a weekend in Dingle, and other course-related field trips.

\$4350 includes tuition, housing, course related and excursion expenses, and health insurance.
