Joel is the chief international officer of the University of Missouri-St. Louis. In that role, he provides leadership for all UM-St. Louis international activities.

As a land grant university, UM-St. Louis is actively engaged in many community programs and problem-solving efforts. As a long time faculty member at UM-St. Louis (thirty-four years), he is very familiar with faculty resources across the university (and across the metropolitan area) and will work to identify and involve other faculty members to play a role in the project. His own academic expertise is in the fields of comparative politics and Chinese studies.

Joel also is deeply involved with the sister city program in St. Louis. He has been President of the Nanjing-St. Louis Sister City Committee for more than fifteen years. In addition, the Center for International Studies that he directs, cooperates with all of St. Louis' sister city programs. He is personally involved with many civic and community organizations that have an international focus.
