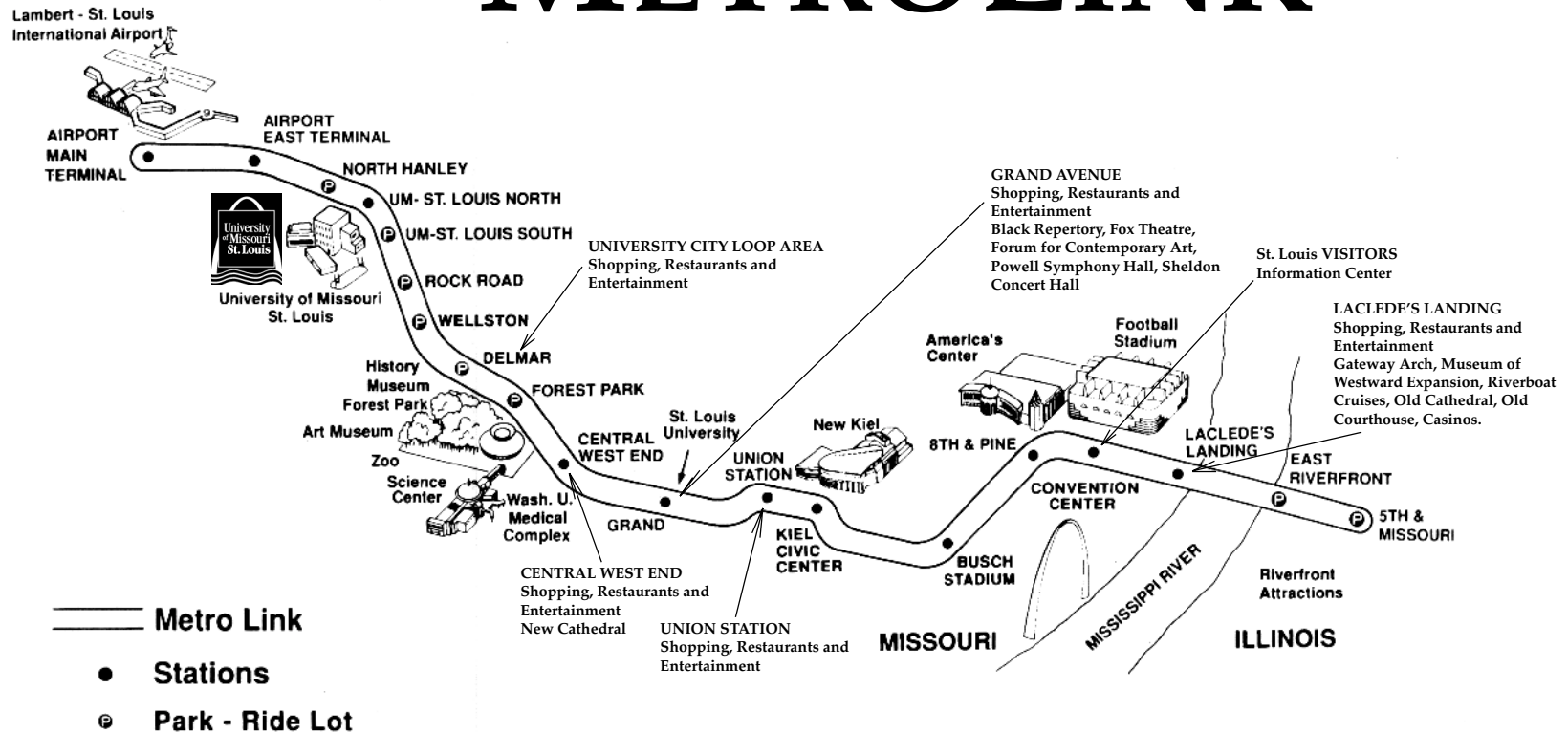

METROLINK FARES

MetroLink features a proof-of-payment fare collection system. There are no turnstiles or ticket agents, and MetroLink operators do not sell tickets or collect fares. You must carry proof that you have paid your fare. Valid proof of payment can be a metroLink or bus ticket; a valid buss transfer; or a daily, weekly or monthly pass. Be sure you have your proof of payment BEFORE you get on MetroLink.

Tickets may be purchased from Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs) at all stations by following the complete instructions printed on the machines. TVMs make change in coins only. At some time during your trip, you may be asked to show your proof of payment to a MetroLink Fare Inspector. If you do not have it, you'll be issued a summons and be required to pay a substantial fine.

All tickets used on MetroLink must have the date and expiration time stamped by a red validator (ticket stamping machine) located on the station platforms. If you purchase a one-ride ticket at a TVM, it will be automatically validated (dated and timed). Tickets purchased or obtained elsewhere, and multi-ride tickets, must be date and time stamped at the station in the red validator BEFORE you board MetroLink.
