Dr. Joel Glassman is Associate Provost for Academic Affairs, Director of the Center for International Studies, and Associate Professor of Political Science, University of Missouri-St. Louis. He received his Ph.D. in 1974 from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, after completing his dissertation on educational policy in China. His current research interests include: education in China, U.S. foreign policy in East Asia, and U.S. economic relations with the Pacific Rim countries.

As Director of the Center for International Studies, Glassman provides administrative leadership and exercises responsibility for planning and coordinating the comprehensive international education program of the University, in consultation with the Chancellor, Provost, and Academic Deans. Also, he directs the University's Office of International Student and Scholar Services which coordinates and provides services for international students and scholars including recruitment, admissions, immigration, orientation, and nonacademic advising. In addition, he is responsible for supporting faculty research in international studies, coordinating and supporting internationalization of the curriculum across the campus, negotiating and administering exchange agreements and relations with foreign universities, directing study abroad programs, promoting faculty development abroad, and developing community education programs with international focus.
