## Conference Keynote Speakers

From 1994-2000, he served as the founding Director of the Feinstein Institute for Public Service at Providence College, the first in the nation degree-granting program combining community service with the curriculum. Dr. Battistoni has written a number of books and articles, including *Civic Engagement Across the Curriculum: A Resource Book for Faculty in all Disciplines* (Campus Compact, 2002).

**Dr. Lori Vogelgesang**, UCLA, is currently responsible for research and assessment in the Office of Residential Life at UCLA. She recently served as the Director of the Center for Service-Learning Research at the Higher Education Research Institute (Graduate School of Education and Information Studies), where she directed a national longitudinal study of the impacts of service-learning.
