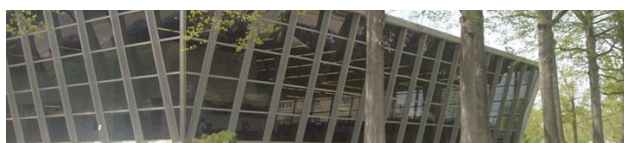

Three Campus Libraries

The **Thomas Jefferson Library** (North Campus. 314-516-5060) contains thousands of book and periodical subscriptions in a variety of disciplines such as the social sciences, humanities, sciences, and business. The Thomas Jefferson Library also has numerous items in microfilm and microfiche and is a United States Federal Government Documents Depository.



The collection of the **Ward E. Barnes Library** (South Campus. 314-516-5576) is focused on nursing, optometry and education.

The **St. Louis Mercantile Library** (North Campus –Thomas Jefferson Library building, Ph.: 314-516-7240) founded in 1846, is the oldest cultural institution west of the Mississippi. The Mercantile collection is comprised of an extraordinary variety of books, manuscripts and art focusing on St. Louis and the Westward Expansion. The Mercantile Library houses two important archival libraries:

- ❖ The Herman T. Pott National Inland Waterways Library, a collection that focuses on American inland rivers and some coastal waters.
- ❖ The John W. Barriger III National Railroad Library, one of North America's largest and finest railroad history collections.



In addition, the UMSL Libraries house two independent archival collections within the Thomas Jefferson Library:

1. The **University Archives** (314-516-5129), a collection of the documents and records of the university.
2. The **Western Historical Manuscript Collection** (314-516-5143), a joint collection of the University of Missouri and the State Historical Society of Missouri, concentrating on collections documenting the history of St. Louis and the surrounding area.

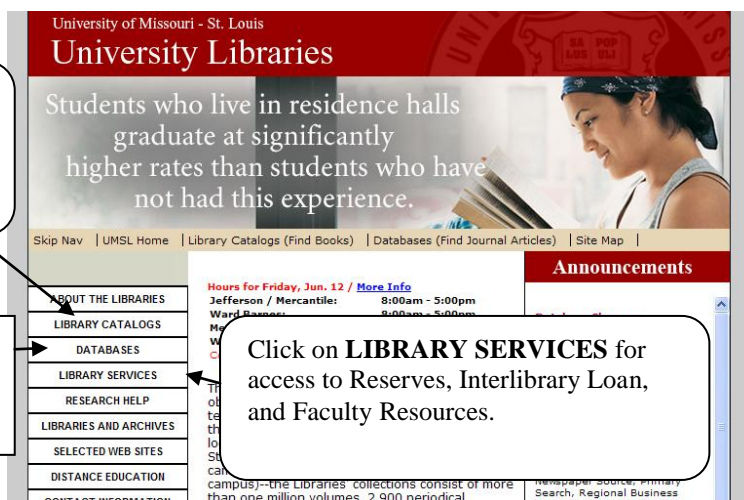
Library Instruction

The **MOBIUS Union Catalog** allows faculty and students to retrieve books from over 60 universities in Missouri.

Peer-reviewed, full-text journal articles are available to faculty and students through subscription databases.



Interlibrary Loan

Reserves

Faculty can request that items be put on Reserve for their classes. More information can be found at **LIBRARY SERVICES**; then, click on the option for **RESERVES**.

Photocopying at the UMSL Libraries

Copiers at the UMSL Libraries accept cash for copies at \$.10 cents a page, but they also accept the same payment card as other Printing Service satellite copiers on campus. Faculty should contact their department to find out copying procedures.

Library Selectors and Departmental Liaisons

- Each department on campus is represented in the library by one of our staff members. This person consults with the departmental liaison and selects new materials to be added to the libraries' collections.
- If you have a suggestion for a book/resource the library should purchase, please contact the library selector or your departmental liaison.
- To find the appropriate library selector or departmental liaison, select **LIBRARY SERVICES** then click on **FOR FACULTY**.
