



# 2008-2009 HEALTH PROFESSIONS Student Loan Application

**HPSL**

The Health Profession Student Loan program (HPSL) is administered by the Department of Health and Human Services. All students who apply for this loan must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The amount awarded will be determined by the number of applications and fund availability. The interest rate on the HPSL is 5%. The borrower will not be responsible for any interest until the start of the repayment period. A one year grace period follows completion or termination of full time status. Additional options are available including deferment, forbearance, renegotiation, and consolidation. More detailed information on these options will be provided when you complete your entrance interview (an exit interview will also be required prior to graduation) at the time you sign your promissory note.

### What You Should Do:

- Please print the student's name and social security number at the top of all documents submitted.
- Submit the following to the University of Missouri-St. Louis Financial Aid Office:
  - this completed worksheet,
  - a copy of your ( and spouse's, if applicable) and your parent's 2007 signed Federal income tax return(s), and
  - any other documents required by the University of Missouri-St. Louis. **All required forms are due by 08/31/2008.**
- If you have questions about completing this form, you may contact the UM-St. Louis Financial Aid Office for assistance. If information on this worksheet is different than information on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) you may be required to submit additional documents for clarification. If corrections of your FAFSA information are necessary, UM-St. Louis will electronically send those corrections to the federal processor who will send you an Information Acknowledgment 2008-2009 Student Aid Report for your records.
