Professional Criteria

Please outline your professional qualifications according to the points below. Please include a current copy of your CV and documentation for each of the points you meet.

___ Receipt of nationally or internationally recognized prizes or awards for outstanding achievement in the academic field. Student or postdoctoral awards are generally not prestigious enough to be included.

___ Membership in associations in the field which require outstanding achievements. Leadership positions can also be very helpful.

___ Documentation of published material in professional or major trade publications or major media written by others about your work in the field

___ Participation on a panel, or individually, as a judge or reviewer of the work of others in the same academic field

___ Evidence of original scientific or scholarly research contributions to the academic field. This is generally accomplished through letters of support from recognized experts in the field. The letters should detail your standing in the field, the significance of your contributions to the field. One to two letters can come from UM St. Louis faculty. The quality of the letters is much more important than the quantity.
