



UMSL Databases **Also** Available at St. Louis Area Public Libraries

Databases available from the University of Missouri-St. Louis are remotely available only to faculty, staff, and students of the University. However, an array of St. Louis area public libraries provide access to many of the same databases. Because of “reciprocal agreements,” most residents of St. Louis County, the City of St. Louis, and St. Charles County are eligible to get library cards from the other public libraries in these areas. Obtaining a library card from an institution with a database in which you are interested usually allows you to gain remote access to that database.

Not Available at UMSL

Many of the public libraries subscribe to databases which are not available at UMSL, but are of high enough quality and content to be useful for University researchers. Because of “reciprocal agreements,” most residents of St. Louis County, the City of St. Louis, and St. Charles County are eligible to get library cards from the other public libraries in these areas. Obtaining a library card from an institution with a database in which you are interested usually allows you to gain remote access to that database.
