



## Online TEAM SPORT Sign-up

**imleagues** is a website specifically designed for college intramural departments. A few of **imleagues'** features include online sign up, customizable team pages, message boards, league schedules, and more.

**All intramural team sport participants will be required to create an account on imleagues.com.**

**imleagues** offers a [live support button](#) in the top right corner of all pages, please use this button if you encounter any difficulties.

### **To create an Imleagues account:**

1. Go to [www.imleagues.com](http://www.imleagues.com)
2. Click on the “**Sign Up**” link.
3. Enter your information, and use your **UMSL email address** (@umsl.edu), and submit.
4. You will be sent a temporary password to your UMSL email account – if you do not receive an email with your temporary password add [info@imleagues.com](mailto:info@imleagues.com) to your list of contacts, go to <http://www.imleagues.com/ForgetPassword.aspx> and enter your email address to have your password re-sent to your email address.
5. Log in to **imleagues.com** by clicking the link at the bottom of the email. You'll be prompted to change your password upon first login.
6. After changing your password, the University of Missouri-St. Louis school link should pop up. Click “**Join School**”.

### **How to sign up for an intramural team sport:**

1. Log in to your **imleagues.com** account.
2. Click on the “University of Missouri-St. Louis” link.
3. The current team sports should be displayed toward the bottom of the screen. Click on the sport you wish to join.
4. Choose the league you wish to play in (Coed, Men’s A, Men’s B, Women’s, etc.)
5. You can join the sport one of 3 ways:
  - a. Create a new team (For team captains)**
    - i. Captains can invite members to their team in 2 ways:
      1. If student has already registered on imleagues: click the “invite members” link on the team page, search for their name, and invite them
      2. If student has not yet registered on imleagues: Click the “invite members” link on the team page, then click the “Can’t find someone? Click here to invite by email address”, and input the student’s email address.
  - b. Join a team**
    - i. Students can join an existing team in 3 ways:
      1. Find a team and captain’s name on division page and request to join
      2. Go to the captain’s player card page, view his/her team, and request to join
      3. Accept a request from the captain to join his/her team
  - c. Join as a free agent**
    - i. Students without a team affiliation can join the Free Agent team
