Volunteer of the Year Eligibility Criteria

- Nominations must be **received** by the Volunteer Services Office by **Friday, April 3, 2009**

Selection Criteria

The Volunteer Services Awards Committee will rank the volunteer nominees in each category based on the following criteria:

- **Initiative** - What steps the volunteer has taken to improve the department’s processes or the campus in general.
- **Sustained commitment** - An established commitment of on-going volunteer work with UM-St. Louis.
- **Impact** - A demonstrated impact from the work that the volunteer has undertaken.
- **Innovation** - Ways in which the volunteer used innovative or exemplary approaches to complete their volunteer service.
