Please note that if you do not pass the Missouri Content Assessment test before the deadline for your start date, you will NOT be able to continue in Teach in 12 courses.

SECONDARY EDUCATION CERTIFICATE SEEKERS: If your previous degree(s) is in an academic area that is not closely related to the Missouri Secondary Education Certification subject area in which you wish to be certified, the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) has asked that we recommend that you supplement your Teach in 12 coursework with courses in your subject area. DESE recommends minimum of 24 credit hours in the subject area you wish to teach. These courses can be from UMSL, at the community college level, and/or courses from other accredited universities. Taking these courses will help to assure that you have mastered the content in your area of concentration.
