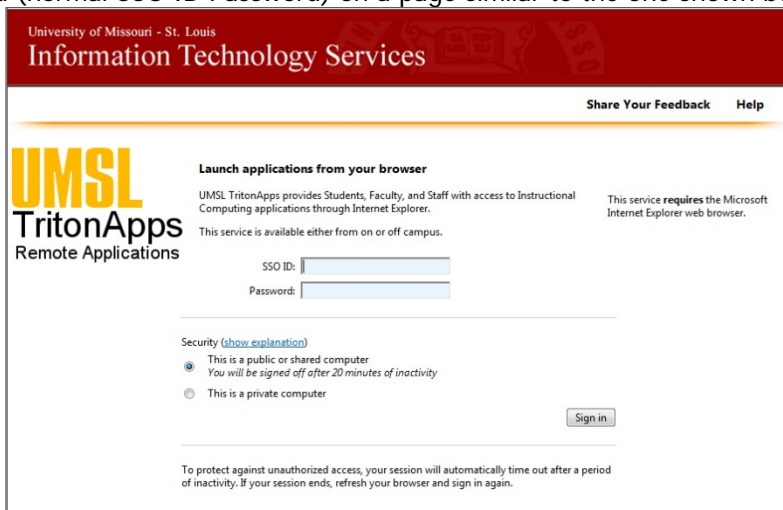




UMSL TritonApps is a virtual network that allows users to run Instructional Computing programs with a web browser.

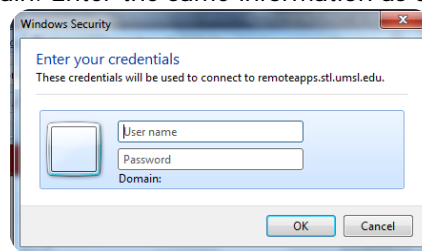
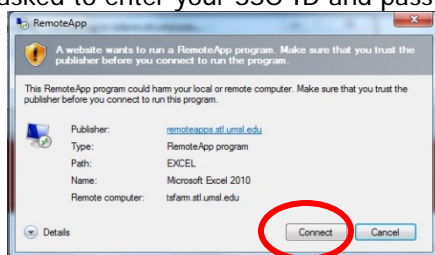
1. To start off you must use Internet Explorer and a Windows Based PC. The screenshots in this help sheet will be based upon Internet Explorer 8.
2. In the URL, type <https://tritonapps.umsl.edu> and press enter.
3. You will be prompted with entering your SSO ID (yourssoid@stl.umsl.edu) and password (normal SSO ID Password) on a page similar to the one shown below.



4. Once you login, you will see a webpage with applications similar to the image below.



5. To launch a program, left click once on the program icon. A dialog box will appear prompting you to click connect as shown below on the left, click the circled connect button. You will be asked to enter your SSO ID and password again. Enter the same information as step 3.



6. The program functions the same as having it installed on your computer once it opens. Users can also save files to their personal K: Drive.
