Students need to consult the transfer guide for their major in order to take courses that will transfer as either general education or major field requirements. If a major has not been chosen, the general education transfer guide shows the courses that are common requirements to most UMSL degrees.

Students should initiate contact with their transfer school during their first semester at SCC and maintain contact throughout their enrollment at SCC. EVERY COURSE TAKEN AT SCC SHOULD BE CONFIRMED BY THE TRANSFER SCHOOL AS TRANSFERRING AS A GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR THE STUDENT'S MAJOR. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that their credits will transfer.

Should you experience difficulty transferring your SCC coursework to another institution, contact the Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs for assistance with an appeal to the receiving institution.

Consult with your UMSL advisor before taking any course that transfers as any type of elective to determine transferability of that course toward your program of study at UMSL.

IMPORTANT: Students earning the 42 hour general education block or Associate of Arts Degree will automatically meet the lower division general education requirements for UMSL.

If CPT 115 was taken before Fall 2012, CPT 115 will transfer as INFSYS 1800, but taking the INFSYS 1800 proficiency exam at UMSL is strongly recommended in order to measure preparedness for INFSYS 1800.
