

**Articulation Agreement
Between
Saint Louis Christian College
And
University of Missouri Board of Curators on Behalf
of the University of Missouri- St. Louis**

This document specifies the terms for a transfer alliance between the University of Missouri-St. Louis (hereafter UMSL) and St. Louis Christian College (hereafter SLCC) that is intended to benefit students at both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to the awarding of college credit by UMSL for courses successfully completed by students at SLCC.

This articulation agreement is intended to prepare SLCC students for the UMSL baccalaureate degree. To insure the SLCC student has maximized the transferability of courses in the current Associate of Arts in General Studies, the student must follow the recommended plan of study attached.

It should be noted that this plan of study would not lead to the completion of the published SLCC Associate of Art in General Studies. The course plan attached is specific to students wishing to transfer to UMSL and the SLCC transcript will be so noted upon degree completion.

This agreement would be effective with the 2007-2008 academic year.
