HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Below are lists of John Wood Community College courses. Each list corresponds to a requirement in the UMSL General Education Program and the John Wood Community College courses on that list will transfer and fulfill all or a portion of that requirement. Unless stated otherwise, all Bachelor degree programs at UMSL include these requirements and so a student wishing to attend John Wood Community College and not complete an Associate in Arts degree can select courses from this guide to fulfill each of these requirements and know that they will apply to just about any major.

NON-GENERAL EDUCATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Cultural Diversity 1 Course

Foreign Language

Students pursuing a Bachelor of Arts degree at UMSL must complete the third-level course of a foreign language. Without placement, proficiency examination, or other exemption of coursework, this requires the completion of two prerequisite foreign language courses as well. A Crowder College student that completes one of the following foreign language sequences will have their UMSL Foreign Language requirement considered satisfied upon transferring.

Chinese Sequence

- CHN 101 Elementary Chinese I (4)
- CHN 102 Elementary Chinese II (4)

* CHN 102 transfers to UMSL as CHINESE Level I, Levels II and III can be taken at UMSL.

German Sequence

- GER 101 German I (4)
- GER 102 German II (4)

Spanish Sequence

- SPN 101 Elementary Spanish I (4)
- SPN 102 Elementary Spanish II (4)
