What will be due:

A disk with an operating project consisting of four forms.

1. startup
2. Loan calc
3. Thanks
4. about

The project will be called loancalc.vbp  
 We will add each of the forms by project/ add form/ new and connect them through buttons and menus. After the forms are added, we'll save the project in the root directory of a floppy disk. It would be wise to make backup disks as we work on this, because disk failures are frequent.

Make sure to set project properties so that the project starts on the startup form. Turn on Tools/ Options / Auto syntax check and Options/ environment/ prompt to save project.
