- For roundtable discussions (4-5 participants), please include an abstract describing the group's focus and each member's expertise.

Submission deadline for Abstracts: November 14th. Email submissions can be sent to balduski@umsl.edu. Hard copies can be placed in the faculty mailbox of Kim Baldus).

Students will be notified about their inclusion in the conference by November 27th. A draft of the presentation will be due to conference organizers by Monday, December 3.

The top 2 entries as selected by an Honors faculty committee will each receive a \$100 award.
