



## Athletics – NCAA Division II

Intercollegiate teams known as the *Rivermen* and *Riverwomen* have established UM-St. Louis as legitimate National Collegiate Athletic Association and Great Lakes Valley Conference powers. Basketball, soccer, baseball, swimming, men’s tennis, volleyball, softball, and golf teams have participated in post-season NCAA tournaments, while individual athletes have gained district, regional, and all-American honors.

Men’s intercollegiate teams began competition in the NCAA during the fall of 1969 and in the MIAA Conference in the fall of 1980. Fall of 1997 the University began competing in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. Men’s intercollegiate competition includes baseball, basketball, golf, soccer, and tennis.

Women’s intercollegiate teams began competition in the MIAA Conference and the NCAA in 1982-83. Fall of 1997 the University began competing in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. Women’s teams have participated in the NCAA post-season tournaments, and several women athletes have received regional and all-American honors. The women’s program includes basketball, golf, soccer, softball, tennis, and volleyball.
