Director for Research

The Director for Research, a tenure-track position at the associate or professorial rank, will report to the Associate Dean for the PhD Program and Research, will be responsible for stimulating expansion of the research enterprise within the College of Nursing, and will teach in his or her area of expertise. Required: Doctorate in nursing or a related field.

Salary and rank are competitive and dependent upon the candidate's qualifications and experience. The factors on which candidates will be evaluated include the following:

1. A doctorate in nursing or a related field;
2. Licensure as a registered nurse in Missouri prior to employment if candidate is a nurse;
3. Expertise in biostatistics preferred;
4. A track record of extramurally funded research indicative of the potential to sustain a program of research;
5. Evidence of the ability to collaborate effectively with nursing and interprofessional colleagues; and,
6. Academic experience and scholarly accomplishments indicative of future scholarly potential, and as appropriate for rank.

This listing is intended to inform prospective candidates of the factors upon which their candidacies will be evaluate. The absence of one or more of these factors will not necessarily cause a candidate to be removed from consideration or potential appointment.
