The faculty member in this position will teach in the MSN program and will provide clinical supervision for MSN students specializing in one of the college's nurse practitioner emphasis areas.

1. A master's degree in nursing and national certification as a Nurse Practitioner in a particular emphasis area;
2. Licensure as a registered nurse in Missouri and recognition by the Missouri Board of Nursing as an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse prior to employment;
3. Doctoral degree in nursing or related field is highly desirable;
4. Demonstrate the potential for translating research into practice and securing funding for clinical demonstration projects;

6. Relevant teaching experience is highly desirable.
