Job Description
Non-Tenure Track Undergraduate Faculty Position

Description of position: The faculty member in this non tenure track teaching position will teach in the BSN program as appropriate to his or her areas of expertise and will provide service to the College and University through committees and professional involvement as appropriate.

Justification of needs for the position: This position is needed to meet the educational needs of students in the Baccalaureate of Science in Nursing degree program. This position is necessary in order to provide the essential clinical expertise for students and to enhance clinical learning experience for nursing students. This person in this position is expected to interface with faculty members conducting research by working as part of a team to identify clinical research questions, participate on research teams as appropriate to meet students' educational needs, and develop strategies for teaching and demonstrating evidence-based nursing practice. The person in this position will report to the Director of the Undergraduate Program in the College of Nursing.

Essential functions: The essential functions of this position are listed below.

1. Participate in the ongoing development, evaluation, and enhancement of undergraduate level curricula for nursing students;
2. Collaborate with the Director of the Undergraduate Program and the College's Clinical Coordinator to identify the types of clinical practice needed for optimal clinical education of BSN students;
3. Teach undergraduate nursing courses as appropriate for area of expertise;
4. Supervise students in clinical courses as assigned;
5. Participate in course meetings;
6. Participate in the evaluation and ongoing enhancement of the BSN curriculum;
7. Contribute to service within the College of Nursing by participating in faculty meetings and on committees;
8. Collaborate effectively with other faculty and staff members both within the College of Nursing and throughout the University and beyond to develop interprofessional academic, clinical, and research utilization opportunities.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications:

1. A master's degree in nursing;
2. Licensure as a registered nurse in Missouri prior to employment;
3. Doctoral degree in nursing or related field is highly desirable;
4. Demonstrate the potential for translating research into practice;
5. One year clinical experience; and
6. Relevant teaching experience as appropriate for rank.
