You are encouraged to seek financial assistance for travel from your school district or local service organizations such as Kiwanis, Lions, Rotary, Jaycees, etc. Some students and teachers may want to attend regardless of the criteria and may do so by paying a **\$140 fee** to cover all expenses for the three-day event. Fees cannot be returned after February 15.
