



2011 STARS TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING

Maps for your campus will be included in the June 6 registration package.

Ask your mentor (or their representative) at the June 6 luncheon for detailed directions to their location. You may purchase stickers prior to June 6; you must follow all restrictions for your campus' parking area.

METROLINK trains/buses: Each student may want to consider purchasing a MetroLink pass on their own prior to the program for transportation to and from your mentor's location. This pass will allow you to ride the MetroLink train and public buses whenever needed. Washington University – School of Medicine Campus parking office also sells Metrolink tickets.

UMSL PARKING for Group Sessions on Mondays & Wednesdays: We will email all STARS participants in May to ask if you will be parking a vehicle on the UMSL campus for Monday and Wednesday group sessions. If you reply yes, a parking sticker will be mailed to you (valid 6/6 – 7/15) with detailed instructions on the back. **You MUST park in the student parking areas only** or you will be ticketed. http://www.umsl.edu/misc/Maps/08_2008/UMSL%20MAP_north08%202607.pdf

If your mentor is at the University of Missouri-St. Louis:

- As mentioned above, we will email to ask if you will be parking a vehicle on the UMSL campus. If you reply yes, a parking sticker will be mailed to you with detailed instructions on the back.
- Parking stickers are valid from 6/6 - 7/15. You MUST park in the student parking areas only or you will be ticketed.

OTHER CAMPUS' PARKING (you must purchase your own permit):

If your mentor is at the Danforth Plant Science Center:

- There is no fee for parking at the Center. Arrangements for stickers will be made on your first day there.

If your mentor is at Saint Louis University – Frost Campus:

- Students are to purchase parking permits for \$50. Permits are valid from 6/6 - 7/15.
- Contact person is Ann Gioia, 314-977-2957, agioia3@slu.edu.
- Parking Services Office is in Room 33, DuBourg Hall, 221 North Grand Boulevard; hours 8:30 am – 5 pm.
- Parking in the Laclede Avenue garage or the Olive Boulevard garage.

If your mentor is at Saint Louis University – Health Science Center Campus:

- Students are to purchase parking permits for \$50. Permits are valid from 6/6 - 7/15.
- Contact person is Marsha Ostmann, 314-977-8656, mostmann@slu.edu.
- Parking Services Office is in Room 1063, Salus Center, 3545 Lafayette Avenue; hours 7:30 am – 4:00 pm.
- Parking is in the Hickory Avenue East Garage.

If your mentor is at Washington University– Danforth Campus:

- Students are to purchase parking permits for \$48. Permits are valid from 6/6 - 7/15.
- Contact person is Audrey Smith, 314-935-5629, smithau@wustl.edu. Parking and Transportation Office is at 700 Rosedale, one block northeast of Skinker and Delmar, directly behind the Pageant Theatre (Building 500 on the Washington U. Hilltop Campus map).
- Students may park in lot 2 or lot 4 in the yellow areas. These are the two large lots on the east end of campus in front of Brookings Hall. Maps are available at www.parking.wustl.edu/parkingmap_2009.pdf. **Parking in red areas will NOT be allowed with this permit.**
- Students choosing to purchase the parking permit should also be prepared to provide all vehicle information, including license plate number, when purchasing the permit.

If your mentor is at Washington University – School of Medicine Campus:

- Students are to purchase parking permits for \$53 for surface lots. Permits are valid from 6/6 - 7/15.
- The office does sell Metro Weekly, Monthly and 10-pack coupon booklets.

- Washington U. Medical Center Campus Parking Office is in Room 114, 4550 Scott Avenue. The sign on the front of the building reads Olin Residence Hall. Office hours are 8:00 am - 1:00 pm and 2:00 - 4:00 pm.
- Some lots are gated so if the gates are down, you will need to press the intercom button to have them open the gate. Please ask the Parking Office to explain this in more detail.
- Students choosing to purchase the parking permit should also be prepared to provide vehicle information, including license plate number, when purchasing the permit.
- Central West End Metro Station is located within the Medical Center.
