DEGREE NOTES:

* Courses are to be selected in consultation with the student's University of Missouri- St. Louis faculty advisor. The advisor can provide the student with lists of courses that satisfy these specific degree requirements.

Beginning in the fall of 2009, formal admission to the College of Business Administration is by application through an academic advisor in the College of Business Administration. New students will self declare themselves as "pre-business" students. They will continue to have business as their academic unit and be advised in business, but they will not be formally admitted to the College of Business Administration until they file a formal application. **Students not formally admitted to the College of Business Administration will be limited to no more than 15 hours of upper division business (BUD AD) courses.** Please contact the UMSL College of Business for more information: (314) 516-6109.

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Accounting. 60 hours must be completed at a four-year, baccalaureate granting institution.

A minimum of 50% of all Business course work must be completed at the University of Missouri- St. Louis.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri- St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.
