## **DEGREE NOTES:**

\* Approved Elective courses should always be chosen based on your major and the transfer institution. If a student shows computer literacy proficiency skills through testing, the *CIS 124 Introduction to Data Processing* may be substituted by an Approved Elective course.

**Course requirements for the Four Year Traditional Nursing program are subject to change. Please consult an academic advisor before enrolling.**

Students must file a separate application available through the College's website or Office of Student Services. Students should complete an application for clinicals during their last semester of enrollment in prerequisite coursework. Please contact the University of Missouri- St. Louis College of Nursing for more information on application or admission requirements.

A 15 month accelerated program is available to students with either a Bachelor's degree in another discipline or 62 hours of general education credit. These students must also have a GPA of 3.2 to be eligible.

A minimum of 125 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.

Please seek advisement from your Jefferson College Academic Advisor for assurance of Associates degree completion.
