Students completing an Associate in Arts or and Associate in Applied Science degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general Education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division course in the major.
