If the proficiency sequence is incomplete at time of transfer, students will be required to take the UMSL Foreign Language Placement exam before being permitted to take additional foreign language courses.

Students completing an Associate in Arts or an Associate in Applied Science degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major

Maximum of 60 hours may transfer without AA
